I received a new Sprite/Midget catalog from Moss Motors and noticed they are selling "Collectors Choice" engine oil. They say it's a must for you classic engine because it contains higher zinc and phosphorus levels to help prevent premature camshaft lobe wear (I have been talking about this serious problem with the new oils) and prevents oil seal hardening from infrequent use and has additives to combat effects of humidity and moisture while storing your classic. If you have not already found a way to add ZDDP to your oil or found a strategy to preserve your MG's engine, I highly recommend you use this oil or one like it. It comes as a 20W-50 weight (perfect for your MG) and is \$6.95 a quart (part # 220-810) or save money and order a case of 12 quarts for \$69.95 (part # 220-810). Call Moss Motors to order at 800-667-7872.

BOSTON BAKE BEANS ASPARAGUS BITES
